Covid 19 safe system of entry to our Churches for Private Prayer

We are glad to be able to welcome you back to church for private prayer.

Due to the continued risk from the Covid19 pandemic we ask that you follow the advice below when you come to pray.

The key messages briefly are:

Social Distancing – the 2-metre rule applies at all times.

Hygiene – the 20 second rule with soap and running water, or the use of hand gel, must be followed.

Church Access – is limited to 2.30pm & 3.30pm each Sunday. However, on occasions, this may change, but we will let you know via the website & church door.

Cleaning – we will ensure that hard surfaces are wiped down before & after the church has been open for private prayer.

Please read this more detailed information before coming to church for private prayer:

Self-Isolation: do not come to church if you meet the following criteria:

- o Have a high temperature, a new persistent cough, or have recently lost your senses of taste & smell.
- o Are a vulnerable person (by virtue of age, underlying health or clinical condition or are pregnant).
- o Are living with someone in self-isolation or a vulnerable person.

Hygiene:

- o Please wash your hands with soap and running water for at least 20 seconds before you arrive at church & then use the hand sanitizing facilities at the church when you arrive & when you leave the building.
- o If, having attended church for private prayer you develop symptoms of coronavirus over the next few days, please let our Administrator know, so we can shut the building for cleaning: 01666 825019

Church Access: access will be through the normal doorways.

- o We may need to ask you to wait if others are already inside the building. We will allow only a maximum of **6** in church at any one time.
- o For track & trace purposes, we would be grateful if you would provide us with you name & contact details.
- o Please make sure you always keep 2 meters away from others inside the building, & as you enter and exit.
- o As far as possible doors will be kept open during times for private prayer, to improve ventilation.
- o Please follow all advice given & respect others.

• Cleaning:

- o Common areas such as door handles, pews etc. will be cleaned by an allotted person with disinfectant before and after the church is open.
- o Waste bins will be emptied regularly by an allotted person
- o Please make us aware of any shortages or issues regarding hygiene.
- o Toilet facilities will not be available.
